Project Experiment: Cornstarch & Water

Materials:

- A tray to put a muffin tin on
- Muffin Tin
- Three clear cups for colored water
- Blue, Yellow, Red food coloring (primary colors)
- Spoon or eyedropper for collecting color from cups
- A bowl of cornstarch

Start with water/food coloring cups of and allow them to mix colors until they loose interest. Comment on what you see and how they are doing it.

- What does the cornstarch feel like
- What happens when cornstarch is added
- What can you discover about color
- Do you remember how you made the green?
- I notice your tray is full would you like it empty to do more?
- When you see the color _____ what do you imagine or think of or see
- Write down your observations over the next week and post them where your child can see them and put a picture of your child doing the project and place it next to the words. Read it to your child when they ask. Then if you want to take it further put it in a book you save for their art projects.

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
