## Project Experiment: Tempera Painting

### Materials:

- Red, yellow, blue & white tempera paint in clear jars or squeeze bottles
- Crafts sticks or popsicle sticks for mixing
- Assorted size paint brushes
- Heavy white paper for painting
- Bucket of water
- Paper towels

Set items in the center of the table and white paper at child's seating. Here are some ideas to work with. Remember to look for what your learning from your child's work and not teaching but rather invoking curiosity.

- What colors can we make with these primary colors
- What happens when you add white to the primary colors
- What colors are strong and what colors are weaker
- Is there a size brush you like better
- I see you having fun or curiosity or \_\_\_\_\_
- How would a dot be made, what about a line
- Write down your observations over the next week and post them where your child can see them and put a picture of your child doing the project and place it next to the words. Read it to your child when they ask. Then if you want to take it further put it in a book you save for their art projects.

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
